



FULL DAY - 1 DIA NO RIO

Check out our 1 day itinerary in Rio de Janeiro. See all the tips, information and details of good options to enjoy the wonderful city in 1 day. Although 1 day is a short time in the city, we have prepared an itinerary with the main and most incredible points of Rio de Janeiro. To enjoy your trip even more, nothing better than great places on your itinerary in the wonderful city.

DESCRIPTION: Traditional city tour, a day in Rio visiting the best-known spots in the city.

FEELING: Pure excitement.

FREQUENCY: Every day

TRANSPORTATION: Van

DURATION (including transportation):* Approximately 9 hours.

DISTANCE: 50 km within the city

BOARDING TIME: from 07:45 a.m.

BOARDING TIME: Zona Sul and (City center to be consulted)

WHAT'S INCLUDED: Transportation, accredited tourism guide, lunch (free buffet), ticket for the Cristo Redentor (van), ticket for the Pão de Açúcar.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED: Beverages, desserts, additional services, and internal visits to the Maracanã.

ITINERARY: Cristo Redentor, Pão de Açúcar (Sugarloaf Mountain), Sambódromo, Maracanã (external visit), Catedral Metropolitana (Metropolitan Cathedral) e Escadaria Selarón (Selarón Stairs).

CHILDREN: Children aged 0 to 2 years old (on lap) are free / Children aged 3 to 10 years old pay half price with proper identification.

RESTRICTIONS: Thermal bags, coolers, iceboxes, drones, and similar items are not allowed.

IMPORTANT: Bring photo ID to prove age when there is inspection and bring sunscreen if you need it.

Nothing better than starting the day at the famous Cristo Redentor (Christ the Redeemer), the greatest symbol of Rio de Janeiro and Brazil. You can visit this attraction right at the beginning of the day, this being one of the coolest and most touristic tours to do in the city. For you to have an idea, the Christ is 30 meters high and is located at the top of Morro do Corcovado, 710 meters high, providing a beautiful and unique view of the entire wonderful city.

Visiting Pão de Açúcar (Sugarloaf Mountain) is one of the best things to do in Rio de Janeiro. In this attraction there is a cable car that takes tourists to the top, where the view is very beautiful. Know that you can go to Morro da Urca and then climb even higher, to Sugarloaf Mountain. Each route lasts 3 minutes, is all made of glass, allowing you to look out over the city and admire the beautiful view of the beach. From both hills you can see the Rio-Niterói Bridge, the neighborhoods of Ipanema and Copacabana, Cristo Redentor (Christ the Redeemer) and Pedra da Gávea.
