Get to know the Angra dos Reis Bay with its islands and the main beaches of Ilha Grande on this tour that departs from Rio de Janeiro. We will start the tour leaving the city of Rio de Janeiro, with a stop before arriving at the boarding point (it may be boarding in Conceição de Jacareí or Angra dos reis), where the boat trip begins.

The boat has a capacity of approximately 120 people, equipped with bathrooms, live music, food service, diving mask, floats, and everything necessary for a comfortable ride in a paradisiacal destination, guaranteeing safety and comfort.

Once boarded, the passenger will be able to enjoy the privileged landscape of Costa Verde, with scheduled stops to swim and dive in its crystalline and warm waters, accompanied by many small and colorful fish.

#### **Ilha de Cataguases:**

An island that has a peculiar formation due to two small stretches of land originating from the Serra do Mar, it is one of the most beautiful islands in the Bay of Ilha Grande.

#### **Lagoa Azul:**

A natural aquarium where we find one of the most beautiful diving spots on Ilha Grande. An immense pool with transparent water, whose bottom is a sky of starfish, with schools of colorful fish, squid and coral. Don't forget your bathing suit.

**Freguesia de Santana:**

The beach of Freguesia de Santana was an important industrial and agricultural center in the 17th century, with extensive plantations of sugar cane, coffee and vegetables. The main attraction of the place is the Church of Santana, built in the 18th century. The Church of Santana is also one of the main attractions of Ilha Grande.

**Praia de Japariz:**

It is one of the most famous and visited beaches due to its great beauty and where we stop for lunch.
